Under the Project, The Ministry of Food, Agriculture and Light Industry is seeking to recruit **the qualified national individual** to carry out following duties for the Project.

A. NATIONAL CONSULTANT SERVICE TO UNDERTAKE IMPACT ASSESSMENT OF THE DRAFT LAW ON LIGHT INDUSTRY AND PROPOSE AMENDMENT RECOMMENDATIONS ON THE DRAFT LAW

A. OBJECTIVE OF THE ASSIGNMENT

The main objective of this assignment is to analyze and assess the impact of the draft law on Light industry based on relevant laws, legislations and research.

As a result of this consultancy, in accordance with Law on Legislation of Mongolia, 1) Assessment of the impact of the draft law on Light industry will be made, and 2) Proposal and recommendations will be made to make necessary amendments to the Light industry draft law and other relevant laws.

B. SCOPE OF WORK

The consultant will carry out the following tasks, but not limited to:

Task 1. In accordance with Article 12, provision 12.1.3 and Article 17 of the Law on Legislation of Mongolia, the impact of the draft law on Light industry shall be assessed and recommendations shall be made as follows:

- i. Analyze the draft law and its provisions, their feasibility and coherence,
- ii. Eliminate duplications, gaps, inconsistencies in the draft law,
- iii. Identify the potential and unforeseen consequences of adopting and implementing the draft law.

Task 2. Assess the impact of the implementation of draft law, if necessary, develop a proposal to revise the draft law or some of its provisions.

C. DELIVERABLES

- i. Detailed work plan;
- ii. Draft report on the impact assessment of the draft law on Light industry conducted in accordance with “Methodology for assessing the impact of the draft law” approved by the Government of Mongolia in the third appendix of the Resolution No.59, 2016.
- iii. Considering the impact of adoption and implementation the draft law, if necessary, provide a proposal to revise the draft law or amend some of its articles and provisions;
- iv. A final report with relevant corrections (4 hard copies and electronic version) in accordance with the comments and recommendations by the Client after reviewing Deliverables (ii-iii).
